We can all do something to help save our planet – each month there will be a challenge for you to do at home, at work or at

November's Challenge — Turn off electric lights if you are not in the room— turning the lights off when you're not using them can help save money by reducing your electricity bills, extend the life of your light bulbs, and buy bulbs less often. Turning your lights off is essential when you go out of your room for a few minutes. Doing so can make your home more energy-efficient

• How it helps – It helps save energy. It can also help reduce carbon emissions and other harmful greenhouse gases. Hence, turning off your lights is a simple way to help protect the environment and save the planet. The advice for fluorescent lighting is if you or others will be out of a room for 15 minutes or less, leave it on. If you or others will be out of a room for more than 15 minutes, turn it off. The amount of energy used to reignite after 15 minutes is less than the benefits of being off for more than 15 minutes.
