News from the Daylight Centre (17th Sep)

"Nothing like the rise in numbers that Kettering has seen" but the numbers of food parcels going out from the Centre are beginning to increase. Harvest gifts are now coming in which are really appreciated as donations from the supermarkets is diminishing. Therefore our help is still needed to support families in food poverty and the homeless. Work continues at the Daylight Centre itself which is also getting busier offering appointments for assistance with benefits, housing and medical issues. Light lunches and refreshments are also now available to them in the Centre.

Stocks are now running low on: Savoury Rice, Mug Shots, Cup-a- Soups, Pot Noodles, Fruit juice (not grapefruit) and there is always a need for UHT Whole Milk (not semi-skimmed), the smaller child-sized cartons of fruit juice, Sugar, Coffee, Biscuits, Crackers (savoury biscuits), Washing Powder tabs, Packets of rice (basmati, wholegrain etc), Boil-in-the-Bag Rice, Jelly (in cubes or already made up in pots), Custard (packets, tins or boxes), Tinned rice pudding, Instant Whip Desserts,), Jam, Tinned Fruit, Toilet Rolls, Fruit Squash, Boxes of Breakfast Cereal, Weetabix (or similar breakfast biscuit), Pasta Pots, Packet Noodles, Tinned spaghetti, Tinned Potatoes, Tinned vegetables, Small Tins of fish (sardines, tuna etc), Tins of meat (eg Stewing Steak, Meat Curry, Minced Beef etc) including Fray Bentos Tinned Pies, and Kitchen Roll. Spray Deodorant for ladies and men, and cheap tin openers (for the homeless) are also always welcome. Thank you.
