### **News from the Daylight Centre (29th Oct)**

I have received a letter of thanks from the Daylight Centre for our Harvest gifts which we took to them following last Sunday's service. A copy of the letter is on the church notice board. Week by week they sincerely appreciate all we take to them as donations for the food bank. They were particularly pleased to receive the dog food and dog biscuits on response to last week's appeal. The Mothers' Union are reviving the initiative of supplying wash bags for the (mostly) men which will be given out through the Daylight Centre. I have 10 wash bags to fill so any donations of shower gel, shampoo, razors, combs, soap etc will be very useful.

Stocks are now running low on: Tinned Fruit, Tinned rice pudding, the smaller child-sized cartons of fruit juice, Jam, and there is always a need for UHT Whole Milk (not semi-skimmed), Fruit juice (not grapefruit), Sugar, Coffee, Biscuits, Crackers (savoury biscuits), Washing Powder tabs, Packets of rice (basmati, wholegrain etc), Savoury Rice, Boil-in-the-Bag Rice, Mug Shots, Cup-a- Soups, Pot Noodles, Jelly (in cubes or already made up in pots, Toilet Rolls, Fruit Squash, Boxes of Breakfast Cereal, Weetabix (or similar breakfast biscuit), Pasta Pots, Packet Noodles, Tinned spaghetti, Tinned Potatoes, Tinned vegetables, Small Tins of fish (sardines, tuna etc), Tins of meat (eg Stewing Steak, Meat Curry, Minced Beef etc) including Fray Bentos Tinned Pies, Custard (packets, tins or boxes), Instant Whip Desserts, and Kitchen Roll. Also Spray Deodorant for ladies and men, and cheap tin openers (for the homeless) are also always welcome. Thank you.
