News from the Daylight Centre (29th Oct)

Christmas will soon be upon us and we thought it would be good to do a **SECOND BIG ASK** for Christmas 2021. The Daylight Centre Food Bank are in touch with around 100 children and homeless people. We think it will brighten their Christmas if we can give each one a Christmas chocolate selection box. Current prices are £1.00 each for a Cadbury's selection box. Please will you help us to reach 100 boxes this year? You all did a magnificent job in 2020, I would like to think we can do it again. Please cheer a child up this Christmas. Donations of boxes or money (and we will purchase the boxes), will be gratefully received. These need to be delivered to the Food Bank by 6th December. Thank you very much. **SO FAR WE HAVE RECEIVED 62 – THANK YOU.**

Thank you to everyone who generously supports the Food Bank.

Stocks are now running low on: *Fruit juice (not grapefruit), Microwaveable Rice, Tinned Custard, Tinned Fruit and there is always a need for UHT Whole Milk (not semi-skimmed), Sugar, Coffee, Biscuits, Crackers (savory biscuits), Washing Powder tabs, , Tinned rice pudding, the smaller child-sized cartons of fruit juice, Jam, Packets of rice (basmati, wholegrain etc), Savoury Rice, Boil-in-the-Bag Rice, Mug Shots, Cup-a-Soups, Pot Noodles, Jelly (in cubes or already made up in pots, Toilet Rolls, Fruit Squash, Boxes of Breakfast Cereal, Weetabix (or similar breakfast biscuit), Pasta Pots, Packet Noodles, Pasta, Tinned spaghetti, Tinned Potatoes, Tinned vegetables, Small Tins of fish (sardines, tuna etc), Tins of meat (eg Stewing Steak, Meat Curry, Minced Beef etc) including Fray Bentos Tinned Pies, Custard (packets or boxes), Instant Whip Desserts, and Kitchen Roll. Also Spray Deodorant for ladies and men, Dog food, and cheap tin openers (for the homeless) are also always welcome.*

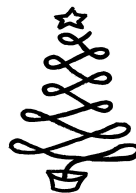
