

News from the Daylight Centre ()

A SECOND BIG ASK - THANK YOU SO MUCH WE TOOK 109 SELECTION BOXES TO THE FOOD BANK ON MONDAY – They were so appreciative and thank you all very much for spreading a little cheer at this difficult time.



There has now been an increase in requests for help from the Food Bank, numbers are doubling so your help is even more important. They urgently need small bottles of hand sanitiser (handbag-sized).

Stocks are now running low on: Crackers (savoury biscuits), Crisps, Fruit juice (not grapefruit), Coffee(100gm jars), Custard (tins or packets), Cup-a-Soups, Pot Noodles, and there is always a need for UHT Whole Milk (not semi-skimmed), Sugar, Biscuits, Washing Powder tabs, Tinned rice pudding, the smaller child-sized cartons of fruit juice, Jam, Packets of rice (basmati, wholegrain etc), Savoury Rice, Boil-in-the-Bag Rice, Microwaveable Rice, Mug Shots, Tinned Fruit, Jelly (in cubes or already made up in pots), Toilet Rolls, Fruit Squash, Boxes of Breakfast Cereal, Weetabix (or similar breakfast biscuit), Pasta Pots, Packet Noodles, Pasta, Pasta & Sauce, Tinned spaghetti, Tinned Potatoes, Tinned vegetables, Small Tins of fish (sardines, tuna etc), Tins of meat (eg Stewing Steak, Meat Curry, Minced Beef etc) including Fray Bentos Tinned Pies, Instant Whip Desserts, and Kitchen Roll. Also Spray Deodorant for ladies and men. Dog food, and cheap tin openers (for the homeless) are also always welcome. Thank you.
