News from the Daylight Centre (15th April)

URGENT - The funding has now run out for the Food Bank, so they are now existing on what is donated. They have no spare money with which to fill in for shortfalls. The stock piles are diminishing rapidly so please whatever you can donate will be really appreciated. Especially urgent this week is Jam, Pot Noodles, and Cup-a-Soups. The Food Bank volunteers are so grateful for your regular and continued support. One other urgent need is empty egg boxes for 6 eggs. They are given trays of eggs to pass on to families but need to re-box them to ensure they arrive safely. They have run out of boxes, please pass any on to us if you have some spare ones. Thank you.

Stocks are now running very low on: *Toilet Rolls, Packet Noodles, Tinned Fruit, Pasta Pots, Mug Shots and Pasta & Sauce, Sugar, Crackers (savory biscuits), Crisps, Washing Powder tabs, Tinned rice pudding, Fruit Squash, Fruit juice (not grapefruit), the smaller child-sized cartons of fruit juice, Coffee (100gm jars), Biscuits, Jelly (in cubes or already made up in pots), Boxes of Breakfast Cereal, Weetabix (or similar breakfast biscuit), Tinned spaghetti, UHT Whole Milk & Semi-skimmed Milk, Tinned Potatoes, Tinned vegetables, Tinned pulses (butter beans, kidney beans etc), Packets of rice (basmati, wholegrain etc), Savoury Rice, Boil-in-the-Bag Rice, Microwaveable Rice, Pasta, Small Tins of fish (sardines, tuna etc), Tins of meat (eg Stewing Steak, Meat Curry, Minced Beef etc) including Fray Bentos Tinned Pies, and Tinned Custard, Instant Whip Desserts, and Kitchen Roll. Nappies in size 5 and size 6 (no need for expensive ones) are also helpful at present. Also Spray Deodorant for ladies and men, Dog food, and cheap tin openers (for the homeless) are also always welcome. Thank you.*
