

News from the Daylight Centre

At Harvest time we thank God for his provision of food for us, and we show our generosity in providing food for the Daylight Centre Food Bank. Please bring with you on Sunday any of the items listed below, or any of the **Urgent Needs, which this week are Jam, Jelly, Pasta Sauces, Pulses and tinned Fruit.**

Your kind donations of food for the food bank and gifts of money are very much appreciated. Thank you WEBS Benefice for all that you do.

Please buy something from the list below, it doesn't have to be expensive - a jar of jam is 39 pence and tin of peaches is available from 39 pence. Every item you can donate really does go to those in need of help. Your support is much appreciated. Thank you.

You can bring any items to church on a Sunday or give to us at 2 Manchester Road, Wollaston.

We really appreciate everything you can give to help feed hungry people. Thank you also for all the egg boxes, these are really helpful. Thank you to everyone who supports the Daylight Centre Food Bank.

The Food Bank always needs: UHT Milk (whole & semi-skimmed), Toilet Rolls, Jam, Tinned Fruit, Fruit juice (not grapefruit), Custard, Tinned vegetables, Pasta Sauce and Crackers (savoury biscuits), Pasta Pots, and Pasta & Sauce, Cup-a-Soups, Sugar, Pot Noodles, Packet Noodles, Mug Shots, Crisps, Washing Powder tabs, Fruit Squash, the smaller child-sized cartons of fruit juice, Coffee (100gm jars), Biscuits, Boxes of Breakfast Cereal, Weetabix (or similar breakfast biscuit), Tinned spaghetti, Tinned Potatoes, Tinned vegetables, Tinned Tomatoes, Tinned pulses (butter beans, kidney beans etc), Packets of rice (basmati, wholegrain etc), Savoury Rice, Boil-in-the-Bag Rice, Microwaveable Rice, Pasta, Pasta Sauce, Small Tins of fish (sardines, tuna etc), Tins of meat (eg Stewing Steak, Meat Curry, Minced Beef etc) including Fray Bentos Tinned Pies, Tinned Custard, Instant Whip Desserts, Tinned Rice Pudding, Jelly (in cubes or already made up in pots), and Kitchen Roll. Nappies in size 5 and size 6 (no need for expensive ones) are also helpful at present. Also Spray Deodorant for ladies and men, Dog food, and cheap tin openers (for the homeless) are also always welcome. Thank you.
